Exemption Forms

The Assessment Department also administers partial tax exemptions, as allowed under NYS Real Property Tax Law, to property owners who meet certain eligibility requirements. Some of the most common residential exemptions are: STAR (School Tax Relief), Senior Citizen, Disability With Limited Income and Veterans. Applications are available for these exemptions through the New York State Office of Real Property.

Application forms are also available by contacting the Assessment Office at 585-381-5151. The most common residential exemptions and the corresponding form number are:

RP-425 - School Tax Relief (STAR) Exemption

RP-458-a - Alternative Veterans Exemption

RP-458-b -Cold War Veterans Exemption

RP-459-c - Partial Tax Exemption for Persons with Disabilities and Limited Income

RP-467 - Partial Tax Exemption for Senior Citizens

Per NYS Real Property Tax Law, all exemption applications must be submitted by March 1st of each year.
