



Village Board Members,

The East Rochester Fire Department started off the month of March with our annual inspection banquet. This year we honored members who achieved the mile stones of 25 and 40 years of service. Firefighters Dennis Leo, Richard George and Past President Mark Boch were recognized for 40 years of dedicated service to the ERFD. Past Chief Ted Conners and Warden Rick Slater were recognized for 25 years of dedicated service to the ERFD. Special recognitions were also made to Past Chief Steve Williams and Past President David Vanthof.

The ERFD completed the remainder of our mandatory OSHA training drills in March and will begin training outdoors as we move into the month of April. The smoke detector survey that was conducted in conjunction with the school district was a success. Although there wasn't 100% compliance among the students, the survey results that were gathered showed this to be a positive initiative. The ultimate goal is to work towards implementing a fully functional smoke detector program. Our hope is that with the assistance of several community organizations and grant initiatives, we can secure funding to allow those that are in need of smoke or carbon monoxide detectors to benefit from this program. There were no calls of significance to report.

The East Rochester Fire Department responded to (24) incidents (2) of which were mutual aid to our neighboring departments in the month of March.






