

Village Board Members,

The East Rochester Fire Department continues to invest quality time into firematic training. Our first outdoor drill of the year included live fire training with foam applications, accountability training on the fire ground and vehicle extrication exercises. The members of the ERFD train hard and with great dedication. Without this ongoing training and hours of learning the latest practices and techniques in the fire service, our ability to delivery the highest level of service to the residence and visitors of our community would be deficient.

Our annual Easter Egg Hunt was another success. Children of all ages and their families made the trek down to Eyer Park on 4/19 to find their hidden eggs. With their baskets and pockets full of eggs each child was given a prize from the Easter Bunny. Prizes were also given out in (2) age brackets to the children that found the golden eggs.

The ERFD participated in a state wide recruitment initiative sponsored by The Fireman's Association of the State Of New York (FASNY). We opened up or doors on 4/26 and 4/27 in an effort to educate the community about the volunteer fire service. The hopes were to retain perspective candidates interested in becoming a volunteer firefighter. I am happy to report that this initiative was a success. We handed out (10) applications to interested residence throughout the weekend. Of those we have already received back (5) applications that will begin the membership process.

There were no calls of significance to report. The ERFD responded to (30) incidents in the month of April, (3) of which were mutual aid to our neighboring departments.

§176-15 of the village code states:

Four-hour parking limitation: *residentially zoned areas*, except as otherwise herein provided, no motor vehicle shall be parked on any street or highway located in a residentially zoned area for a period of more than four hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Two-hour parking limitation: *commercially zoned areas*, except as otherwise herein provided, no motor vehicle shall be parked on any street or highway located in a commercially zoned area for a period of more than two hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.


