East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. monthly report for April 2011

- The East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. received **74** requests for service in the month of April and answered **51** of them for a **69%** call coverage. Of the calls responded to **1** was by first responders, **9** were cancelled. Of the calls we missed, **3** were due to no backup crew on the day shift.
 - ERVAC took **14** calls out of district for our neighbors.
 - ERVAC currently has 32 members on our roster. We have 19 members who are cleared to medic a call, 18 who are cleared to drive a call, of those numbers 15 are able to do both positions. We have 3 members in training. 5 members on medical leave and 3 members who are non running and help where needed.
1. We are operating with one ambulance at this time due to mechanical problems.
 2. We voted in 1 new member in April.
 3. We are in need of volunteers on all shifts, especially days and overnights. Anyone interested in volunteering their time should contact the East Rochester Ambulance Corps to inquire about opportunities and monetary incentives. Please call 586-5723 for more information.

Did You Know? All Libraries in Monroe County will be closed May 27th, 28th, 29th and 30th for an upgrade in the circulation database, known as CARL.X.

Regular and Special Programming:

Children's – Babies' Storytime met 3 times with 24 in attendance, the toddler story time met 3 times with 28 in attendance, and the school age story time met 3 times with 20 in attendance. Special Programming included a Family Pajama Storytime with 5 in attendance, and the Tail Waggin' Tutors met with 19 in attendance.

Adult's –The adult's Reading Discussion Group met in April, and discussed Kathleen Kent's The Heretic's Daughter with 17 people attending. The May meeting of the Reading Discussion Group has been cancelled. The next discussion will be June 16, 2011 at 7p.m.; all are welcome to attend this vibrant and fun group.
