Village Board Report May 2016

Village Board Members,

In April the East Rochester Fire Department participated in a statewide recruitment campaign known as Recruit NY. Fire Departments from across the state open their doors to the community with the common goal of increasing members by recruitment and retention efforts. This program continues to be an important and ongoing initiative within our department. I am happy to report that we had four interested individuals who will start the background process in the near future. Our explorer post program is also recruited several new members to their organization as well.

We are starting to get into the busy season with the warmer weather and upcoming events. Our training program is in full swing and we have recently held extra training to prepare for the up coming distracted driving demonstration at the school. Along with our own drills we will be training with the Brighton fire department on May 15th on high-rise operations at St. John Fisher College. We have also taken delivery of a new Hurst eDrualic combination rescue tool. This is a battery operated vehicle extrication tool that will replace an antiquated and problematic gas powered unit.

The fire department has continued our fire prevention program beyond just October. Past chief Mike Romach, and Captain Jim Diego coordinated with the alumni association to hand out a smoke detector to every student in the second grade this past Monday the 9th. The smoke detectors have a tamper proof battery with a life of 10 years. This provides each student a working smoke detector that will last until his or her senior year of high school.

The department will be putting on our distracted driving program at the school this Friday 5/13. This is held every 2 years for the juniors and seniors to teach them about the dangers and consequences that are involved with all forms of distracted driving. It is a very powerful program that we take great pride in putting on with the help of all the emergency service providers, the school, and many local businesses. We hope to reach the new drivers and help them to avoid making a life changing mistake.

The fire department responded to (29) calls in the month of April (7) of which were to our neighboring departments. Most recently we responded for a house fire on 5/7 at 323 East Commercial Street. Upon our arrival we were confronted with heavy fire from the rear of a two family residence. Due to the fast response of our well-trained firefighters the fire was


