Department Head Review:


- Chief Steve Clancy reminded everyone of the upcoming 5K Race on July 27th. He reminded everyone to be patient as traffic will be congested during the carnival.

- Housing Authority Update -108 W. Ivy St. is for sale and 701 Main St. rehab completion is forthcoming.




