## JUNE 2010

- 06/01 A computer business in the Technoplex Mall at 300 Main Street reported a break in . Access was gained through the ceiling from a vestibule, finger prints were taken from the scene.
- 06/03 ER Police responded to a man with a gun call on W. Spruce Street. The juvenile was in possession of a pellet gun and a butterfly knife. He was returned to his guardian, and the illegal weapons were confiscated.
- 06/04 A student at the East Rochester High School reported her wallet stolen from her purse in a classroom. No suspects or witnesses.
- 06/04 A Sycamore Street resident reported that someone smashed the windows out of her car in an attempt to steal it. They were unsuccessful due to that amount of noise they created.
- 06/05 A Rochester resident who was pulled over for a routine traffic stop was arrested for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, when the officer the drugs on the front seat of his car.
- 06/05 Aggravated Harassment was the charge for this E. Rochester resident when he called his ex-wife and stated he was unable to find transportation to return their son in common to her in Palmyra. A phone fight developed and he ended up calling her names and threatening her bodily harm. He was arrested and issued an appearance ticket.
- 06/07 A Pine Street resident reported his bike stolen from his back yard.
- 06/07 A dispute over custody of a child erupted into a fight on West Elm Street. One half of the Combatants left the scene. Charges are pending.
- 06/11 A fight broke out in front the Village Rock at 213 Min St. Upon police arrival the suspect had fled the scene. Paper work has been signed for an arrest warrant.
- 06/11 Two Rochester residents were arrested for Trespass for being on the Rail Road tracks. They were issued appearances ticket to court.
- 06/13 An East Rochester man was arrested after the neighbors reported a man was in a vacant house on W. Chestnut St. He was searched and had a small quantity of Marijuana on him. He gave the Police Officer a fake name to the officer, and was later identified as someone else. He was charged with Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, and False Personating
- 06/14 A domestic dispute became physical after the police had already been on the scene of a domestic and left. Police were called back to the scene by neighbors who witness the female being slapped. The boyfriend was taken into custody and arraigned before a judge and sent to jail.
- 06/14 An East Rochester man was arrested for shoplifting in Debbie Supply. He was issued an appearance ticket for court.
- 6/17 After passing a red light, A Connecticut man was pulled over by an E.R Officer. It was

he was arrested and released to his friends.
- 6/18 A Niagara Falls resident was pulled over for inadequate break lights. It was later determined by the officer that she was driving without a license. Upon searching the vehicle a small quantity of drugs were found in the vehicle. She was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operator, and Criminal Possession of A Controlled Substance 7th. She was arraigned in front of a judge and was taken to Monroe County Jail.
- 06/19 Police responded to a fight in progress on North Washington Street. Upon arrival the victim gave a description of the suspect. He was picked up a short time later and admitted to fighting, but denied pulling a knife on the victim. Both the victim and witnesses stated the suspect had a knife. The knife was found and identified by the victim in the bushes near where the suspect was arrested. He was charged with Menacing 2nd, and sent to Monroe County Jail.
- 6/19 A bachelorette party turned violent when 2 sisters fought on Main St .on their way home from an E. Rochester bar. 1 of the sisters was transported and experienced seizures on her way to the hospital. A witness signed a statement and a warrant has been issued .
- 06/20 A West Elm Street resident reported his lawnmower and an extension ladder missing from his back yard shed. The shed was unlocked.
- 6/20 After a detailed investigation ,an East Rochester resident and a Penfield resident were arrested for Criminal Possession of a forged Instrument and petit larceny when the pair bought lottery tickets at a local convenient store with counterfeit 20.00 bills. These are felony charges so the 2 are in MCJ.
- 06/20 An East Rochester resident pulled over for speeding had an outstanding arrest warrant out of Newark Police Dept. He was issued several traffic tickets and turned over to Newark Police.
- 06/22 A Linden Ave resident reported his neighbor pored kerosene onto his compost pile. The DEC responded along with the East Rochester Code enforcement officer. They will follow up on this complaint.
- 06//23 A dog on Garfield Avenue was attacked by another dog. The dog that was attacked suffered severe injuries and had to be put down. Animal Control will be following up.
- 6/26 A 911 call reported an unresponsive male laying on the ground. When officers arrived they discovered a male lying on his back w/ a bicycle on top of him. He was disoriented and he became increasingly agitated . He refused to cooperate with police and the medical personal that responded. He was yelling obscenities, and was out of control. He was transported to the hospital for observation. It was determined that he had several baggies of marijuana on him. Upon discharge, he was arrested for the Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, Harassment and Public Intoxication.
- 6/28 A 911 came in to ERPD for a female on the ground vomiting. Although they were unsure of the location of her house, the 2 females that accompanied her wanted help getting the sick female home. Upon arrival , the 2 females that were w/ the sick female had run away. The parents were notified and the vomiting 13 year old was taken to the Hospital.  
The police went to the second location , and the parents of the other two girls said the 2 girls (ages14 &15) were at home. One of them had started vomiting. EMS was called and she was transported to the hospital. The Officers went back to the location where the girls were given a quantity of vodka and the 19 year old male was arrested for Unlawfully Dealing With a Child on 3 counts as well as Unlawful Possession of Marijuana.

06/29 An East Rochester man was arrested for Trespass after he was seen on the Rail Road tracks.

06/30 A bicycle was stolen from the Piano Works Mall.

06/30 The Technoplex mall reported Graffiti to the back of its building, the investigation is continuing.

**There were 1,161 calls for the East Rochester Police in June. They assisted at 45 Ambulance calls and 12 Fire calls. There were five drug arrests, and 147 traffic citations issued. The Police are checking on many houses daily, because the owners are on vacation. The Chief of Police is asking the residents of the town to please watch out for our children at play now that School is out.**

1. The East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. answered 57 requests for the month of June.
  - we took 9 calls out of district for our neighbors.
  - we currently have 39 members on our roster and are processing an application for 1 potential new member. We have 30 members who are cleared to either drive or medic a call. We have 7 members in training. We have 4 members who are non running and help where needed.
  - we are still in need of help on our days calls.
  
2. With the current heat wave, make sure you are staying hydrating by drinking a lot of water,
  - minimize your activity in the high heat, avoid exercise until the cooler parts of the day, use
  - sunscreen and check on your neighbors.
  - Be alert to signs of heat stroke:
