### Old Business:

#### Public Comment-response to Public Forum questions of August 4, 2011

Margot Gilhart, 220 Northwood Ave., spoke on the following items:

1. Mrs. Gilhart informed the Board that the weed known as “nutsedge” is growing in Edmund Lyon Park. It is an invasive weed that causes welts and, in her case, requires a steroid to heal. She suggested that it be either dug up by the roots or sprayed in order to remove.
  - A. The “nutsedge” problem will be looked into.
2. She recognized that the parks require constant attention, ie. weeding and watering, and asked the Board to consider either dedicating an employee to the parks during the summer months or hiring some students.
3. She informed the Board that there are areas in the Village where the sidewalks have become overgrown with weeds, and asked what the procedure was for monitoring this.
  - A. Assistant Building Inspector Jim Herko explained that the Village sends the homeowner a notice to address the problem. If it is not addressed within the specified number of days, the Village will remedy the problem and bill the homeowner.
4. She asked about the approval process for the banners.
  - A. The Chamber of Commerce, who is sponsoring the Banner Program, received Village Board approval following a formal presentation to the Board.

Sam Morabito, 30 Dellwood Dr., spoke on the following:

1. He advocated for televising the Public Forum.
2. He advocated changing the order of business on our meeting agendas so that the mundane items would be presented at the end of the meeting.
3. He asked how the \$400,000 that was appropriated for the equipment BAN would be spent.

4. He asked where the money goes from the sale of equipment.
  - A: It either goes into the Capital Fund or the General Fund. In either case, it is used to offset the cost of future purchases.
5. He stated that parking still remains an issue in the downtown area.
6. He asked if anything was being done to clean up the Washington St. underpass area.

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- A. The Village is working with a landscaper to implement ideas for next spring. 70% of what is currently there is supposed to be there. No herbicide exists that will remove only the weeds.
7. Regarding bulk refuse pick-up, he believes that bulk refuse is generated as much or more from single family homes than from multi-units or properties owned by absentee landlords.

Rosali Rosini, 210 Linden Ave, spoke on the following:

1. She thanked Barbara Maine and the YAC for serving lunch at the Sr. Center.
2. She thanked Barbara Maine and the YAC for their involvement in the craft program at Northside Park.
3. She asked the Board to consider placing a "Please stop for people in crosswalk" sign on Linden Ave. at DePaul Dr. to slow cars down on Linden Ave. between Washington St. and Bluff Dr.
  - A. The crosswalk on Linden Ave. belongs to MCDOT. They removed it many years ago.
4. She asked that the Board review our bulk pick-up procedure for more efficiency.
5. She noted the passing of Paul Costantini, long- time owner and operator of Village Fair, and his involvement in the community over the years.

Trustee Flanigan notified the public that Channel 12 is up and running 20 hrs. per day, 7 days per week.

Trustee Conners suggested that letters be distributed to residents on the 500 block of West Ave. to assure them of their safety in the wake of the recent homicide in that area. Following a brief discussion, it was determined that letters would not be sent until the investigation is completed.

Trustee Florack welcomed Steven Clancy to the Police Chief position.

### **Regular and Special Programming:**

**Children's** – Babies' Storytime met 3 times with 37 in attendance, the toddler story time met 3 times with 16 in attendance. Crafty Kids Storytime met 3 times with 32 in attendance.

**Children's Special Programming**- The Steps to a Healthy Planet program met 4 times with 60 in attendance. The two Sing and Sign programs had 34 in attendance, and "Go Wild at the Library" featuring live animals had 50 total participants.

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

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### East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. monthly report for August 2011

- The East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. received **109** requests for service in the month of July and answered **67** of them for a **62%** call coverage.
  - Of the calls we responded to **15** were cancelled. Of the calls we missed, **2** were due to no backup crew.
  - ERVAC took **18** calls out of district for our neighbors.
  - ERVAC currently has 35 members on our roster. We have 19 members who are cleared to medic a call, 17 who are cleared to drive a call, of those numbers 15 are able to do both positions. We have 6 members in training. 4 members on medical leave and 3 members who are non running and help where needed.
1. With warm weather upon us, please use care when doing things outside. Make sure you stay hydrated, stop working when you feel over heated and get in a cool place.
  2. Ambulance 3269 is out of service for mechanical reasons.
  3. Our annual fund drive is currently underway. If you wish to donate to the volunteer ambulance corps, you can do so by mail to 254 West Ivy St.
  4. The 36 members of East Rochester Volunteer Ambulance Corps, Inc. are ready to help you with your emergency needs.

07/01 Two male E .Rochester residents were caught walking down Commercial St. with alcoholic beverages. They were issued appearance tickets for Open Containers and released.

07/02 Patrols responded to Dellwood Dr. for a report of a male shot in the leg. It was determined it was from a pellet gun belonging to a juv. neighbor that was shooting at a target. The mother of juv. did not see anyone around and had given him permission to target shoot. The gun was removed by officers. The neighbor did not wish to prosecute.

07/04 An "excessive noise" ticket was issued to a Lincoln Rd. resident for causing annoyance to neighbors. This location has had several complaints prior for similar incidents.

07/04 A report of "glass breaking" and "bike throwing" lead police to North side Park where they located a male who appeared to be alone. He was issued an "In Park After Hours" ticket; and while in custody, the officers located 3 morphine pills, 20 hydrocodone pills, 4 oxycodone pills and some marijuana. He was additionally charged with Unlawful Possession of Marijuana, and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance.

07/05 Officers were dispatched to a Main St. apartment where there was a female found throwing property out the window. Several deep lacerations were noted on the suspect's arms. While waiting for the ambulance, suspect ran back into the building and attempted to hide. She was located and handcuffed but was very uncooperative with Police. She was transported to the hospital. Police observed that living conditions were deplorable. (Rotten food, feces on the floor) Code enforcement

was notified. The officers also notice damage to the window frame, and a broken the window so the landlord signed a deposition for her arrest. She was charged with Criminal Mischief 4<sup>th</sup>.

7/06 Police were dispatched to a residence after the female caller stated that her husband had walked from the city to her apartment, walked in the front door and snatched a cell phone out of her hand. There was a stay away order of protection against him and he had left the premises prior to the Police responding. A warrant was advised for Criminal Contempt 2nd, Burglary and Grand Larceny 4<sup>th</sup>.

07/06 A West Commercial Street merchant reported having equipment stolen from his business overnight. No signs of forced entry.

07/06 A West Ivy Street resident reported her cell phone being removed from her car overnight.

07/09 An East Rochester resident was arrested for Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle, Criminal Mischief 4<sup>th</sup>, and Leaving the Scene of an Accident, after he took the car for a ride without the owners consent. He lost control of the car and struck a parked car. He then abandoned the vehicle away from the scene of the accident and fled.

07/10 Two North Lincoln Road residents was charged under the Noise Ordinance, after a loud party at their house disturbed the neighbors.

07/10 A female at the above party was charged with Harassment after she struck another party goer in the face. She was issued an appearance ticket to East Rochester court.

07/11 Police responded to a customer trouble on West Commercial Street. The female was arguing with her cab driver, because she didn't have enough money to pay him. She was highly intoxicated, and told the officer she had called a friend, who was coming to assist her. When her friend drove by, it was apparently that he too was intoxicated. He was charged with DWI.

07/11 Police responded to a report of a fight behind the Capri Apartments on Main Street. As they pulled up they observed a male lying on the ground crying. As they helped him up, a marijuana pipe fell out of his pocket. He was charged with Unlawful Possession of Marijuana.

07/12 An East Hickory Street resident reported that someone had broken the side window of his car overnight and removed his GPS unit, and some sunglasses.

07/12 A Pine street youth was caught spray painting his neighbors' fence. Police spoke with his parents, who are willing to clean up the damage.

07/14 Police responded to the 300 block of Magnolia Avenue for suspicious activity. Upon arrival, the officer observed a male walking away from the scene with his shorts on backwards. The man was stopped and admitted to having possession of Marijuana. He was charged with Unlawful Possession of Marijuana and issued an appearance ticket for East Rochester Court.

07/18 An East Rochester Officer responded with the Pittsford Ambulance to the scene of a sickness on Linden Avenue. The patient was spitting and coughing up blood. The officer was advised after the call that the patient has TB and Hepatitis-C. He will follow up testing with own doctor

07/18 A Lincoln Parkway business reported that a window to the office was broken overnight. No signs of entry were found.

07/19 Time Warner cable reported that an East Rochester resident used their son's identity to purchase cable TV. They are being charged with Theft of services and a warrant will be issued by the court

7/22 A black 26" roadmaster bike was stolen from the A-plus min-mart on Commercial St. while the youth was working. No suspects at this time.

7/22 A pink mountain bike was stolen from the bike rack at the E.Rochester School on Woodbine Ave. during summer school. No suspects at this time.

7/22 2 males were issued appearance tickets for open container when Officers observed them drinking "four Locos" in the school parking lot.

7/23 Officers responded to a harassment call on Garfield St. It was determined that the suspect banged on the victims door yelling "ERPD" and when victim opened the door, the suspect barged in causing the door to hit victim in the lip causing bleeding. An arrest warrant has been requested for the ER resident.

7/24 A 911 call indicated that there were several under aged youths drinking at a local establishment. Although there were several youths outside there was no-one under aged located in the bar. The youths were dispersed except for 1 male that refused to leave. It was apparent that he was under the influence of alcohol and became abusive and was yelling profanities. He was arrested for Harassment, Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing and Public Intoxication. He was remanded to Monroe County Jail.

7/25 2 Appearance tickets were issued for 2 separate incidents on the same night for violations of the Noise Ordinance violation. One from a loud party on McKinley St. and one from a vehicle that was blaring music on the Northside of the Village.

7/26 ERPD received many calls to 911 reporting a 5 year old male running down Garfield St. with no clothes on. Officers brought him to ERPD and the Boces school administration responded with shorts and a positive ID. Mother was located at home still asleep and unaware that the autistic child was out of the house. CPS was referred for a follow up investigation. No arrest at this time.

7/26 R/O were called to assist Monroe County Sheriff's dept. for a fight call. A description yielded a female suspect walking down West Commercial St. She was stopped and while the Officer was gathering information, the suspect became irate and "lunged" at the Officer. Suspect was handcuffed and arrested on a Harassment charge.

7/28 An appearance ticket was issued to a male resident who was playing his car stereo loud enough for the Officer to hear it more than 100 ft. away.

07/29 A Despatch Drive business reported finding a door ajar in the back. The door had pry marks and there was equipment missing from the business. Technicians responded and lifted prints from the scene.

07/30 An Oak Street resident reported that in the process of moving, he left his moped near the back shed. Upon returning for another load the moped was gone.
