Our department relies heavily on a successful event to offset operational expenses throughout the fiscal year. Without the support from the community including the many fire departments across Monroe and the surrounding counties, this event wouldn't be successful. As the chairman of carnival and chief I am very proud and thankful of the hard work that the members, past members, and their families put in to make this event a success.

The fire department responded to (36) calls in the month of June (1) of which was to our neighboring departments. On the evening of Monday 7/24 we were called out for a hazardous condition at 375 Fairport Road. *Although a tragic scene, the training and awareness of our firefighters with the assistance of the Monroe County Haz Mat team ensured that the situation was resolved safely.*

Did You Know? Join us at the Library for special events in August, like the Ice Cream Social on Friday, August 19th at 2pm (for all ages). Summer Reading participants include 200 of the youth of East Rochester, with 789 hours of reading to-date! Congratulations!

Regular and Special Programming:

Children's – Babies' Story Time met 2 times with 26 in attendance. Pre-K Story Time met 3 times with 36 in attendance, and Crafty Kids Story Time had special programming from the Department of Environmental Services, meeting 3 times with 68 in attendance.

Outreach- Three visits to the Lois Bird School, (BOCES), had 29 in attendance.

Children's Special Programming- Programs included the Rochester Yoga Preschool, with 53 in attendance, Games Around the World, with 13 in attendance, Airplay Juggling with 35 in attendance, Sport Science with 17 in attendance, and Play With Your Food, with 25 in attendance.

Young Adult- Fourteen teen volunteers worked 62.5 hours.

Adult's –Twelve people attended the Adult book group discussion of The Silent Sister by Diane Chamberlain in July. Copies of the August book discussion novel are available at the Circulation Desk of the Library.




