

Village Board Report October 2015

Village Board Members,

The E.R.F.D. is teaming up with the Penfield, Pittsford & Brighton Fire Districts to apply for a regional communications grant. This US Homeland Security, Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) will allow us to upgrade our radio and communications system to the county's future trucking platform. Without getting into specifics of the new system, these upgrades will allow for more efficient and adequate radio communications countywide. This is an extremely important project and a much needed upgrade that will affect the day to day operations of the fire service. Most importantly, it will keep our firefighters safe during emergency incidents.

On September 22nd we responded to 18 Apple Street for the report of a house fire. First arriving units reported heavy fire in the rear of the structure. We were extremely fortunate that evening that both ER and Penfield had crews out training at the time the fire was reported. This advantage allowed for a faster than normal response and a quick knock down. The coordinated effort between both our first in Engine Company and the Penfield Engine Company, was seamless. This prevented the fire from spreading and causing a significant loss of property. The sole occupant was not home at the time. The fire was contained to the exterior and interior rear wall and the floor joists above the kitchen.

October is Fire Prevention Month. Our members will be busy throughout the month discussing fire safety at the school district, the fire house and throughout the community. We encourage all families and community members to review and practice your fire safety plans.

The East Rochester Fire Department responded to (20) incidents in the month of September, (1) of which were to our neighboring departments.


