

Village Board Members,

The fire department members have been training diligently on our new Engine 323. As standard pumping operations have not changed, there are several new options on the truck that our members need to be acclimated with (i.e.: foam cell, re-gen, light tower etc.) We anticipate the truck to be placed into service with-in the next two weeks. The truck committee which consisted of Past Chief Williams and the current line officers spent many long hours during all phases of this project to make this truck a success. We feel that this new engine will serve us in many capacities and will allow us to continue to delivery the highest level of service to our residence and visitors.

On September 23rd we responded to McKinley Street to assist the police with an incident. The incident evolved quickly and as a result it was determined there was a fire on the second floor of the single family home. I would like to acknowledge and commend the quick actions of Lt. John Tando, Officer David Franz and a neighbor, who assisted (2) family members out of the resident safely. As I arrived on-scene this was all unfolding. I can tell you that as rapidly as the fire was progressing, the actions of these officers and the neighbor prevented a much more tragic outcome.

The ERFD responded to (38) incidents in the month of August, (5) of which were to our neighboring departments.


